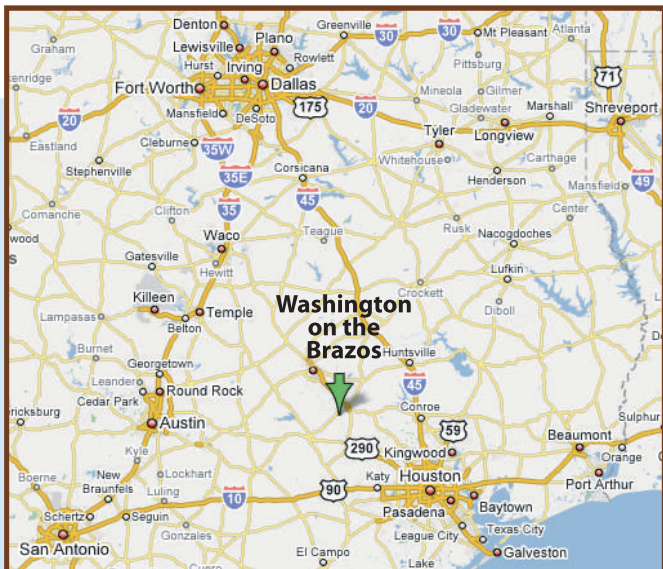


The **South East Texas Tomato Festival** is an open-to-the-public tomato tasting and get-together for gardeners, foodies, and tomato enthusiasts.
